



SALES OF LOGS *PTEROCARPUS TINCTORIUS* (MKURUNGU) THROUGH ELECTRONIC AUCTION

1. The Tanzania Forest Services Agency (TFS) intends to sell **8,950** pieces of *Pterocarpus tinctorius* (Mkurungu) logs with total volume **656.219 m³** located at Ubungo Inland Container Depot (ICD) in Dar Es Salaam.
2. The logs stored in 29 containers will be sold through a public auction in accordance with Regulation 31 (ii) of the Forest Regulations (2004).
3. The auction will take place on **Monday 31st October, 2022** from seven 07:00Hrs (morning) to 16:00Hrs (afternoon).
4. Participant is invited to inspect the property at Ubungo ICD from 9:00Hrs to 15:00Hrs local time on Monday to Friday except holidays. The inspection will last from the date of advertisement to **Thursday 27th October, 2022**. TFS staff will be available to provide additional information.
5. In order to participate in the auction, the participant will be required to register through the following address <http://mis.tfs.go.tz/e-auction> from the date of this advertisement until eleven (23:00Hrs) on **Thursday 27th October, 2022**. Conditions for participating in this auction

1. A participant will have to register and upload to the e-auction system the following documents and by that will have agreed with terms and conditions: -
 - i. Valid Identity (ID) of the participant (National ID, Passport, Voting ID or Driving license) issued by respective authorities in Tanzania,
 - ii. Certificate of registration for taxpayer identification number (TIN) issued by Tanzania Revenue Authority (TRA),
 - iii. Valid Tax Clearance Certificate issued by Tanzania Revenue Authority (TRA)
 - iv. Valid certificate of registration of dealer of forest produce issued by Tanzania Forest Service Agency (TFS), and
 - v. A Power of Attorney (for a company representative who is not among the company shareholders),

2. A participant will have to confirm his/her participation just after being verified and receiving an email or short message service (sms) before auction start time.
NB: Confirmation after the commencement of the auction will automatically be rejected,
3. A participant who is outside the country must be represented by a person or entity registered in Tanzania,
4. Each lot will be auctioned exclusively depending on its price and existing volume of the respective lot,
5. The successful participant shall pay twenty five percent (25 %) of the total value within 24 hours after concluding the auction which is non-refundable if the buyer fails to complete payment of the remaining balance within the prescribed period. The remaining seventy five percent (75 %) shall be paid within fourteen (14) days from the date of the auction,
6. Successful buyer shall adhere to the Forest Act Chapter 323 and its regulations of 2004 and other guidelines on Forest Produce Trade,
7. All payments should be made through banks or financial service providers' networks after receiving a bill obtained from the Government Electronic Payment Gateway (GePG) that will be available in the participant's account in the electronic auction system,
8. The successful buyer will be obliged to remove the purchased logs within fourteen (14) days after payment of the total value,
9. **A successful participant wishing to export the logs shall apply for a special permit for export which will be granted as government notice (GN) published in the government gazette,**
10. The logs are to be sold on "*as is where is*" basis, and
11. TFS shall have no liability after the sales.

Roles and responsibility of TFS

The Agency has following roles and responsibilities: -
