REGULATIONS

(Made under section 106)

THE FOREST (AMENDMENTS) REGULATIONS, 2017

Citation

G.N. No. 153 of 2004 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Forest (Amendments) Regulations, 2017 and shall be read as one with the Forest Regulations, 2004 hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations."

Amendment of the Schedules

2. The Eighth and Fourteenth Schedules to the principal Regulations are hereby revoked and replaced for them with the following:
